

**Resolution authorizing a Calallen Police Substation to be located at West Guth Park in Council District 1.**

**WHEREAS**, on November 8, 2022, voters approved the City of Corpus Christi's Bond 2022 Program, which included the full design of a Calallen police substation;

**WHEREAS**, the Corpus Christi Police Department has identified that the best location for a Calallen police substation is within the northeast corner of West Guth Park, based on the service area and the proximity to the highway;and

**WHEREAS**, a police substation constitutes a park use under Texas Parks and Wildlife Code § 26.001.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, upon holding a public hearing, finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use or taking of such land; and the Calallen Police Substation project includes all reasonable planning to minimize harm to the land, as a park, recreation area, scientific area, wildlife refuge, or historic site, resulting from the use or taking.

**SECTION 2.** The proposed Calallen Police Substation is authorized to be located at West Guth Park in Council District 1.
