Resolution authorizing an Interlocal Agreement with Department of Health Services (DSHS) for analysis of bay water samples and ratifying acceptance of agreement to begin September 1, 2016

# CAPTION:

Resolution authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the Department of State Health Services (DSHS), in an amount not to exceed \$56,000.00, to provide laboratory services for the analysis of bay water samples for the contract period of September 1, 2016, through August 31, 2018; and to ratify acceptance of the agreement to begin as of September 1, 2016.

## PURPOSE:

To be used to pay for expenses of the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District (City) to test and analyze for seafood safety bay water samples collected by the TDSHS and sent to the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District (County) for the period September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2018.

### BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has awarded a contract in the amount of up to a limit of \$56,000.00 (\$35.00 per water sample) to provide for expenses of the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District to test and analyze for seafood safety bay water samples collected by TDSHS and sent to the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District (City).

## ALTERNATIVES:

Disapprove the contract and discontinue providing water testing and analysis for seafood safety for the TDSHS.
