SUBJECT: Water Conservation Plan Advisory Committee

Corpus Christi Water (CCW) requests the Council's support to establish an Advisory Committee (Committee) that will gather input and recommendations to revise the City's Water Conservation Plan (WCP). The Mayor, Councilmembers, and City Manager shall each select up to three members to serve on the Committee. Meetings will take place over a three-month period starting in January 2025.

The Committee shall consist of stakeholders representing the various customer classes, including: Residential, Commercial, Institutional, or Industrial.

To create an inclusive and effective plan, City staff recommend considering the selection of representatives from the following groups or general community representatives:

- General community members
- Local organizations, schools, and neighborhood associations
- Nonprofits focused on sustainability and conservation
- Environmental and water resource departments
- Experts in hydrology, ecology, and environmental science
- Industries dependent on water, utilities, and technology

The Committee will support the development of strategies for the WCP. Submit the candidates to Nicholas Winkelmann by the end of the day on Friday, December 19, 2025.

Background

The WCP serves as a guidebook and reference manual for Corpus Christi Water, its partners, and customers. As a water supplier, the City of Corpus Christi must have a WCP per state law. The WCP was last revised by CCW and approved by Council on October 13, 2020.
