

Ordinance authorizing execution of all documents necessary to accept, amend, and appropriate a grant contract between the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District in the amount of \$1,550,000 for the period August 18, 2021 through June 30, 2023 for activities to establish, expand, train and sustain public health workforce in support of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) response through the following: hiring four full-time public health positions (two project managers, one public information officer and one accountant), adjusting compensation for current Health District staff who were involved in the pandemic response March 2020 through May 2021, providing indirect cost reimbursement for general government support, and procuring office supplies.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas: Section

Section 1: The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to enter into a contract HHS 0001076700001 with the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) in the amount of \$1,550,000 for the period August 18, 2021 through June 30, 2023 for activities to establish, expand, train and sustain public health workforce in support of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19). The funds are appropriated in Health Grants Fund 1066.

Section 2: The funds are planned as follows: four full-time public health positions (two project managers, one public information officer and one accountant); for compensation adjustments for 48 current staff; for indirect cost reimbursement for general government support; and office supplies.

Section 3: The City Manager or designee Director of the CCNCPHD is authorized to execute any future amendments to the grant contract which extend the contract period or increase or decrease the amount of the grant.

Section 4: A copy of the executed grant shall be filed in the office of the City Secretary.
