Upon determination that the proposed street renaming complies with the City Council policy, the City Secretary shall notify the applicant to submit an official application to the City Secretary in writing, directed to the City Council. Upon determination that the proposed street renaming does not comply with the City Council policy, the City Secretary will notify the City Council of the request and the determination that it does not satisfy the Council policy. Unless otherwise directed by a majority of the Council by the end of the next Council meeting after notification, the City Secretary will notify the applicant of the denial and the reasons for the denial.
