1960's: Emerald Cove Hotel






1965:	Wilber Clark's Crest Hotel was officially open in 1965.

1986-1991:	In the late 80's and early 90's the hotel completed additional renovations which included: Guest Room Updates Fitness Center Gift Shop Game Room Outdoor Bar Exterior Façade Improvements Conversion of the outdoor pool to an indoor pool with roof cover.












New Age of Investment
