

**Resolution authorizing submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Office of the Secretary, for the FY 2026 Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) grant program totaling \$13,519,788.00, with a cash match of \$3,379,947.00, to complete the Taxiway K Reconstruction and West Apron Expansion and the International Drive Rehabilitation Projects at the Corpus Christi International Airport.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council authorizes submission of a grant application by the City of Corpus Christi (“City”) to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Office of the Secretary, for the FY 2026 Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (“BUILD”) grant program for total funding of \$13,519,788.00, with a cash match of \$3,379,947.00 to complete the Taxiway K Reconstruction and West Apron Expansion and the International Drive Rehabilitation Projects at the Corpus Christi International Airport for the Aviation Department.

**SECTION 2.** A cash match is not required to apply for this grant. However, if awarded, there is a cash match requirement totaling \$3,379,947.00 payable from the Aviation Department’s operating funds.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council designates Richard McCurley, Director of Aviation, as the City’s authorized official. The authorized official is empowered to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant and its funding, execute all necessary documents, and administer the grant on behalf of the City as the applicant agency.

**SECTION 4.** In the event of the loss or misuse of these BUILD grant funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Office of the Secretary, in full.
