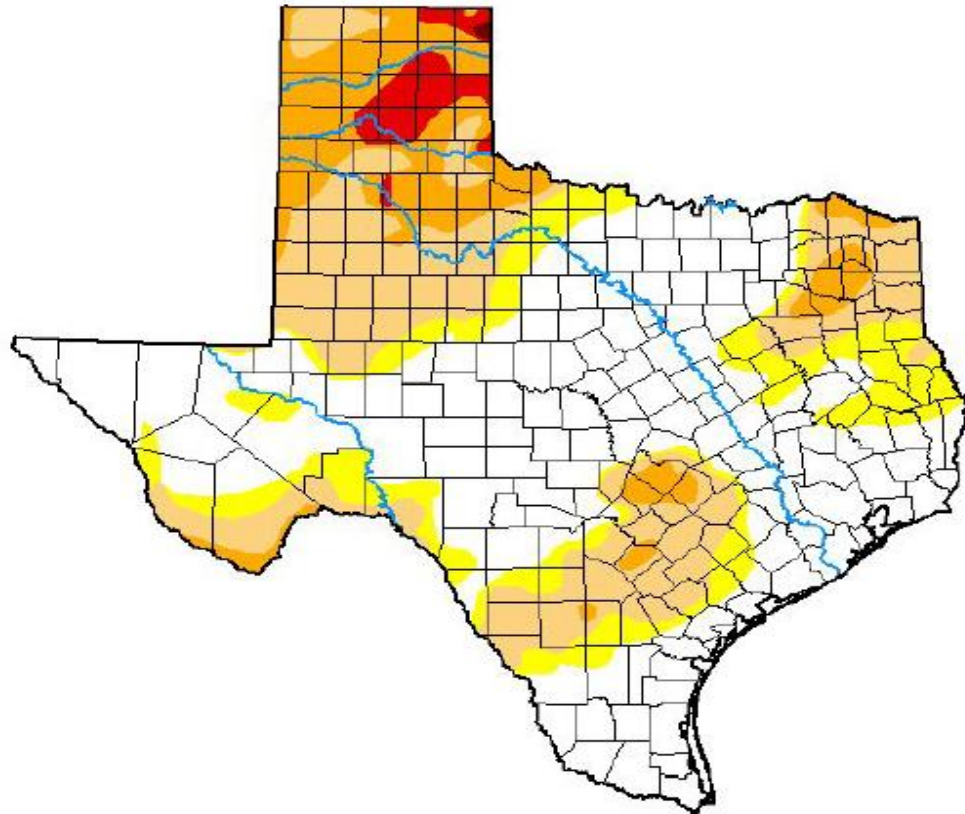

- Water Requested is Available

Ongoing New Water Supply Projects

- **Nueces County Groundwater Program**

- Well production for June has been 75 million gallons for a total of 11 days
- Request to aggregate production across all wells in the western well field was postponed with temporary drilling permits authorized by the Conservation District

- **Wastewater Reuse**

- Greenwood WWTP – Valero has started construction on conveyance line – 3MGD
- Allison WWTP – Flint Hills Resources is in construction – 2MGD
- Oso WWTP – Conveyance line from Oso to Greenwood – 11MGD
- Broadway WWTP – 2MGD

- **Evangeline – San Patricio Groundwater Program**

- SPGCD has retained Judge York for the Contested Case Hearing
- Construction on site continues with 5,193 LF of pipeline installed



Additional Water Supply Projects

- Seven Seas Water Group
 - Driller to mobilize by end of the month
 - Test well to be complete by the end of July
- Inner Harbor
 - Consideration of a contract scheduled for September 1
 - Request sent to TWDB to restructure the loan commitment on June 18
 - Bureau of Reclamation WaterSMART grant is due August 26
- Harbor Island
 - TCEQ intake permit in process
 - TCEQ discharge permit in process
- CC Polymers/Aquatech
 - Letter of Intent to be formalized this week
- Barney Davis
 - Discussion with CPS Energy
