Resolution Authorizing a Letter of Intent to Proceed with an Industrial Seawater Desalination Facility Economic Feasibility Study

### **CAPTION:**

Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Letter of Intent to Proceed regarding Industrial Seawater Desalination Facility Economic Feasibility Study.

## **PURPOSE:**

Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Letter of Intent to Proceed with an Industrial Seawater Desalination Facility Economic Feasibility Study.

### **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

The City of Corpus Christi (City), the Corpus Christi Regional Economic Development Corporation (CCREDC) and local industrial companies held a series of meetings to determine a mutual, collaborative interest in seeking answers to existing questions concerning the location, configuration, and operation of a desalination plant to produce industrial process water.

These meetings established a common regional interest and approach in moving forward together with completing this Economic Feasibility Study. The proposed multi-party Letter of Intent consists of two parts: Part 1 – an engineering study to investigate project alternatives inclusive of costs, siting, water source location, water delivery and concentrate disposition. Part 2 – provides for an option to develop a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a desalination facility. Procurement of both parts will be solicited together under a single procurement.
