Ordinance appropriating \$75,492.28 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Retention Grant funds from Nueces County per the Amended Cooperative Agreement for City-Operated Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District

Summary & Background

- On March 1, 2022, the City became the sole operator of the Corpus Christi Nueces County Public Health District through a cooperative agreement with Nueces County.
- As part of the agreement, former Nueces County employees that were hired on as city employees were entitled to additional pay through the American Rescue Plan Act which was negotiated by Nueces County.
- Through the cooperative agreement, the award was transferred to the City to continue to administer to those employees at the rate determined by the Commissioners Court for the Remainder of the 2021-2022 fiscal year.
- Pursuant to Section 2. A of the Cooperative Agreement between Nueces County and the City of Corpus Christi
 - a one-time payment to 17 former Nueces County employees will be distributed upon receiving the payment from Nueces County (Check was received 1/6/2023).

Fiscal Impact and Staff Recommendation

Fiscal impact

- No fiscal impact as the funds were received from Nueces County and cover 100% of the funding necessary.
- These are one-time funds, and it is not reoccurring.
- The funds will not change current FTE levels.
