Resolution authorizing an Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) for the Leopard Street and Oak Park Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvement Project for a pedestrian walking and bike trail on Leopard Street from Villa Drive to Up River Road with the City's payment of \$14,797.00 to TXDOT for direct state costs, located in Council District 1, with FY 2025 funding from ARPA interest.

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost for State Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA) Program for the Leopard Street and Oak Park Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvement Project is \$848,840.00. Federal participation is \$651,076.00, state participation is \$34,995.00 and City participation is estimated to be \$162,769.00. The City is responsible for 100% of cost overruns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee (Director of Engineering Service) is authorized to execute an Advance Funding Agreement (AFA) for the Leopard Street and Oak Park Avenue Pedestrian Safety Improvement Project with the City's payment to TXDOT in the amount of \$14,797.00 for reimbursement of direct state costs.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all related documents necessary to administer said AFA, including minor amendments thereto.
