Dedicated fee allows for proper maintenance and long-term planning of storm water system

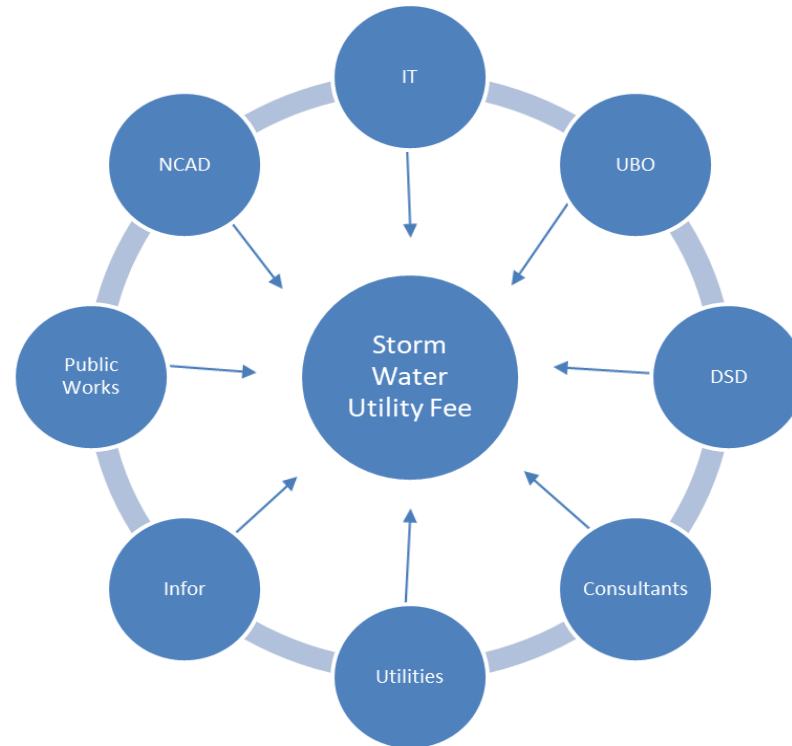

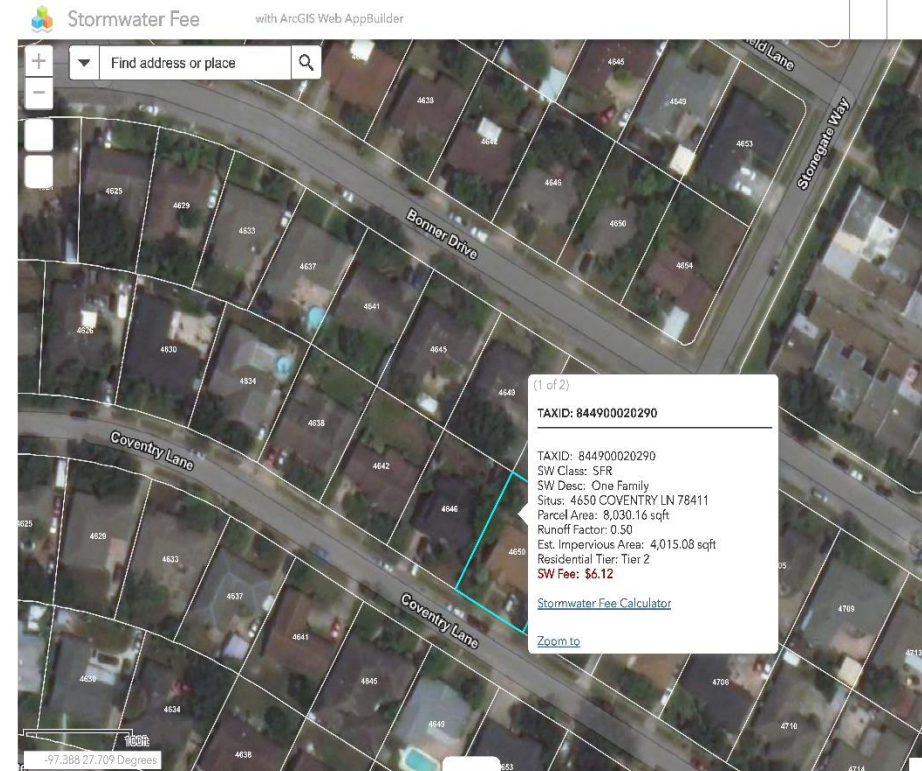

- Street Sweeping - Additional In-House Sweepers
 - Part of Fleet Vehicle Package in January
 - Current In-House and Contractual = 490 Lane Miles Swept this FY
- Additional Channel and Ditch Maintenance Crew
 - Equipment Spec Sheets submitted to Fleet
 - FTE advertisement to begin in January
- Storm Water Utility Fee Team
 - Fully Staffed
- Storm Water Improvements Construction Contract
 - Glenoak Improvement Plans Complete, Construction to begin Early 2022
 - William Ditch Environmental Permits submitted awaiting comments
