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### Dumpster Collection Services

#### **CAPTION:**

Motion authorizing execution of a five-year service agreement for dumpster collection services with Frontier K2, LLC, of Austin, with an office in Corpus Christi, in an amount up to \$755,639.95, for services provided at more than 60 City properties for the Solid Waste Services Department, with FY 2026 funding of \$13,504.63 from various departmental funds.

#### **SUMMARY:**

Resolution authorizing a five-year service agreement, with Frontier K2, LLC, of Austin, with an office in Corpus Christi, for an amount up to \$755,639.95.

#### **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

Frontier K2, LLC is the incumbent contractor completing a four-year contract for services. Dumpster collection services will be provided to 61 City-owned sites located throughout the City. This is a containerized collection service that requires specialized equipment, which would be cost-prohibitive for the City to own. Services will be provided on a predetermined schedule to meet the needs of various departments requiring this service, and non-scheduled collections for special events or emergencies will be provided on an as-needed basis.

#### **PROCUREMENT DETAIL:**

The Finance & Procurement Department conducted a competitive Request for Bid process to obtain bids for a five-year service agreement to provide dumpster collection services at various city-wide locations. The City received three responsive, responsible bids and is recommending

the award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Frontier K2, LLC of Austin. Frontier K2, LLC has served the City with dumpster collection services and is the incumbent for dumpster collection services. The winning bid represents a 24% increase from the previous bid after no increases for the past 5 years. The new contract includes an additional 10 locations, such as the Bill Witt Aquatic Facility, Police Academy, and Salinas Park.

### **ALTERNATIVES:**

One option is to perform the work internally. However, this approach would require hiring additional staff and acquiring specialized equipment. The estimated first-year cost to establish this service is approximately \$660,000, with recurring annual expenses of about \$301,000.

Another option is to allow each department to conduct its own RFQ for a contract. This would result in multiple contracts, create an administrative burden for both the City and the contractors, and likely lead to less favorable pricing overall.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The fiscal impact in FY2026 is an estimated \$13,504.63 for the remainder of the fiscal year. The remaining estimated \$755,639.95 will be budgeted for the next five years through the annual budget process.
