Priority Need	Priority Level	Description
Accessibility Needs	High	Services and construction of infrastructure to assist persons with disabilities access public facilities
Child Care Centers	High	Facilities for the care of children
Clearance of Vacant Property	High	Removal of trash and mowing of grass/weeds at abandoned properties
Code Enforcement	High	Activities related to the enforcement of the City's building code
Emergency Home Repair	High	Repairs to homes that do not require complete rehabilitation, but need attention to pressing issues, such as roof repairs, plumbing, or faulty HVAC systems
Energy Efficiency Improvements	High	Activities undertaken to improve the energy efficiency of residents and commercial structures
Health Facilities	High	Centers where residents can go for health services
Homebuyer Assistance	High	Downpayment and closing cost assistance for low/mod homebuyers
Homeowner Housing Rehabilitation	High	Housing rehabilitation assistance to low/mod homeowners
Housing Demolition	High	Demolition of housing units determined to be uninhabitable
Neighborhood Facilities	High	A variety of facilities use for various purposes within neighborhoods, including parks, recreation facilities, service centers, and community centers
Rental Housing Rehabilitation	High	Repairs to rental housing units targeted to low/mod rental households
Senior Centers	High	Senior Centers for activities aimed at older residents
Water/Sewer Improv	High	Work on water delivery lines and sanitary water sewer/rainwater system
Child Care Services	Low	Services provided in caring for children when their parents are working
Crime Awareness	Low	Services provided to make residents more aware of the potential for criminal activities in their surroundings
Employment/Training Services	Low	Services to provide new job skills to residents
Flood Drainage Improvements	Low	Improvements to systems designed to remove excessive rainwater
Handicapped Services	Low	Services provided to persons with disabilities
Health Care Services	Low	Services provided to meet health care needs of residents
Lead Hazard Screening	Low	Testing to detect hazards in residences
Legal Services	Low	Legal services provided to lower income residents
Parks and/or Recreation Facilities	Low	Parks and facilities where recreational activities are offered
Senior Services	Low	Services provided to older residents
Sidewalks	Low	Construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of public sidewalks
Solid Waste Disposal Improvements	Low	Systems to dispose of solid waste
Street Improvements	Low	Improvements to public streets
Substance Abuse Services	Low	Services provided to help persons wantint to end addictions and other abuse of substances
Transportation Services	Low	Services provided to assist clients with transportation from their home to health care, shopping, and employment centers
Youth Centers	Low	Youth centers for activities aimed at children
Youth Services	Low	Services provided to children and younger residents
