

Ordinance appropriating \$91,997.53 in SPECIALTY BOND PROCEED interest earnings, contributions for Buddy Lawrence house moving, downtown clean-up, and to aid construction, Texas Department of Transportation refund, Public Right of Way fees, reimbursement from the Regional Transportation Authority, Sales Tax Bonds for the Seawall and Arena, Packery Channel Bonds, and Generic Capital Improvement Funds as listed in Attachment 1, Section 4 for the stated bond projects not yet complete, the support of the City's approved Capital Improvement Program, specific military supported projects and as determined by the Type A Board; Changing the FY 2012 Capital Improvement Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 029135 to increase expenditures by \$91,997.53.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI:

Section 1. An amount of \$91,997.53 in Specialty Bond Proceed interest earnings, contributions for Buddy Lawrence house moving, downtown clean-up, and to aid construction, Texas Department of Transportation refund, Public Right of Way fees, reimbursement from the Regional Transportation Authority, Sales Tax Bonds for the Seawall and Arena, Packery Channel Bonds, and Generic Capital Improvement Funds as listed in Attachment 1, Section 4 for the stated bond projects not yet complete, the support of the City's approved Capital Improvement Program, specific military supported projects and as determined by the Type A Board.

Section 2. The FY 2012 Capital Improvement Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 029135 is changed to increase expenditures by \$91,997.53.
