Annual Joint Funding Agreement for Water Resources Investigation with the United States Geological Society (USGS).

CAPTION:

Motion authorizing the City Manager or his designee to renew an annual Joint Funding Agreement for Water Resources Investigation with the United States Geological Society (USGS), U.S. Department of the Interior, for automated river gauging stations to gather and maintain accurate records of all inflows and releases in the City's water reservoir, with the City's cost to be \$140.860.

PURPOSE:

To continue the use of automated river gauging stations to gather and maintain accurate records of all inflows and releases in the City's water reservoir system.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

Texas Water Rights Permit No. 3358 requires specified releases from the reservoir be made to the bays and estuaries. The City utilizes the United States Geological Survey (USGS) to establish automated river gauging stations to gather and maintain accurate records of all inflows and releases in the water reservoir system. The contract period is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015.
