Background and Summary

STD/HIV Prevention Services

- The primary purpose of the grant is to:
 - Investigate and report new cases of Syphilis and HIV to DSHS
 - Intervene in the spread of new cases of syphilis, HIV, chlamydia, and gonorrhea through testing, treatment, and disease investigation
 - Prevent cases of congenital syphilis through disease reporting, disease investigation, and disease intervention
- Grant Period - January 1, 2025, to July 31, 2025

Fiscal Impact and Staff Recommendation

Fiscal Impact

- Total Operating budget is \$61,372
 - There is no fiscal impact. The grant requires no match.
 - The Grant employes one full time employee, and the position is 100% grant funded.
