Mr. Murray advised he met with City staff that day and made a few final revisions to the fuel station lease. They are waiting to be put on the agenda for City Council

**F. Director's Report**

In the director's report, Marina Manager Jonathan Atwood advised the Marina office will be closed Monday the 19th for Martin Luther King Jr Day. The holiday break went without any incident. Mr. Atwood brought up the live aboard issue in League City and how that could impact marinas along the Texas Coast. Marina staff will likely take over the task of marine sanitation device inspections, which is a requirement for live aboards, due to local surveyors retiring.

Mr. Atwood advised piles have been installed on C and D docks, shore side utilities are almost done and then they will start on dockside utilities. A likely completion date is the end of February. The fire marshal has yet to sign off on the fire suppression system. The Coopers Alley boater's facility construction contract will go before City Council on January 27th. The haul out and office bid opens on January 28th for contractors. SR Trident has installed the intermediate piles and utilities are getting tied in this week. A couple of panels had to be custom fabricated, delaying installation by two weeks.
