

**Resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$133,280.26 to the Office of the Governor Homeland Security Grants Division for the Corpus Christi Police Department to provide funding for overtime and retirement for four sworn officers eligible under the FY 2024 Local Border Security Program Grant.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS THAT:**
