Ordinance increasing registration fees for animals not spayed or neutered

CAPTION:

Ordinance Amending section 6-27 of the Corpus Christi Code by increasing registration fees for animals not spayed or neutered; Providing an effective date; Providing for severance; and Providing for publication.

PURPOSE:

To encourage the spaying and neutering of animals, the Animal Control Advisory Committee recommends amending the Corpus Christi Code to increase fees for dogs and cats over six months of age not spayed or neutered.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

Fee increases are:

- 1. The annual registration fee for a dog or cat that has been currently vaccinated with a manufactured one-year or three-year interval rabies vaccination is as follows:
 - Each dog or cat six (6) months of age or younger and each spayed or neutered dog or cat will increase from \$4.00 to \$5.00
 - Each dog or cat <u>over six (6) months of age</u> not spayed or neutered will increase from \$12.00 to \$35.00
- 2. The fee for a three-year registration for a dog or cat that has been currently vaccinated with a manufactured three-year interval rabies vaccination is as follows:
 - Each dog or cat six (6) months of age or younger and each spayed or neutered dog or cat will be \$10.00. This is a new registration fee.
 - Each dog or cat over six (6) months of age not spayed or neutered will increase from \$35.00 to \$105.00
