

## REGARDING COMMITTEE FOR RECONSIDERATION PROCESS

### Recommendations from citizens of Corpus Christi

1. Recommend a group of five citizens who hold library cards to make up the committee. The committee will operate with standard rules of order. The Library Board will appoint the members of this group.
2. This group will reflect the differing political and philosophical views of Corpus Christi.
3. This group will be appointed and serve a four-year term. It is a voluntary group. It will meet in person within 30 days of a request for reconsideration of book being received. The library staff will notify the Chair of the Library Board of such a request and the chair of the library board will notify the group at the latest date at which they must meet. The group will then have 30 days from the date they meet to make a recommendation to the Library Board.
4. This group will read the library procurement policies and fully evaluate the book for reconsideration considering those principles and the members own morals.
5. The group will report their recommendation back to the Library Board. A minority report may also be included.
6. The Library Board will then vote to agree with or not with this recommendation. The Library Board's decision is effective for two years. After that time a citizen may again request a reconsideration of the book.
7. Library staff will comply with the Library Board's decision on the book being reconsidered.
