

Ordinance appropriating Airport Grant No. 73 (a multi-project grant) in the amount of \$7,935,254.00 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) under the Airport Improvement Program for the Baggage Handling System Improvements Project, Taxiway Echo Rehabilitation Project, and design for the West Apron Expansion and Realignment Project in the Airport Capital Improvements Program (CIP) Grants Fund; transferring \$417,645.00 from the Airport Operating Fund to the Airport CIP Reserve Fund for the 5% cash match; and amending the FY 2026 Capital Budget by increasing revenues and expenditures each by \$8,352,899.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Funding in the amount of \$7,935,254.00 received from the FAA under the Airport Improvement Program is appropriated in the Airport CIP Grants Fund. Additionally, funding in the amount of \$417,645.00 is transferred from the Airport Operating Fund to the Airport CIP Reserve Fund for the required 5% match for the Baggage Handling System Improvements Project, Taxiway Echo Rehabilitation Project, and design for the West Apron Expansion and Realignment Project.

SECTION 2. The FY 2026 Capital Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 033731 is amended by increasing revenues and expenditures each by \$8,352,899.00.
