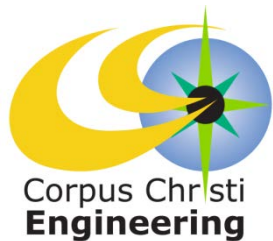


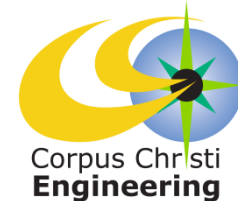

# Project Scope

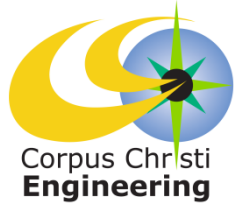


- Ongoing project originating in August 2011.
- Maintenance and real-time data collection of 13 environmental monitoring stations in the Nueces River, Oso Creek and City of Corpus Christi.
- Data is available to the public at <http://www.cbi.tamucc.edu/>
- Data results from (water quality stations) Nueces River used to evaluate raw water quality to optimize water treatment.
- Data results from water level stations along Oso Creek and meteorological stations throughout the City of Corpus Christi are used for watershed modeling and planning.
- Data collection systems, operation and maintenance performed by the Conrad Blucher Institute for Surveying and Science at Texas A&M University - Corpus Christi.

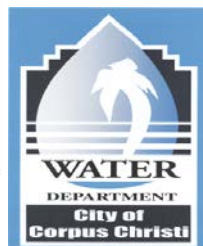
