

Ordinance amending the FY 2014 Capital Improvement Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 029916 by adding \$156,637.50 in Gas Capital Improvement Program Reserves; transferring \$218,862.20 from Wastewater CIP Project No. E12204 Unanticipated Wastewater Capital Requirements to the Bayfront Development Plan, Phase 3 Project; increasing expenditures in the amount of \$156,637.50; authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute a construction contract with Bay, Ltd. of Corpus Christi, Texas in the amount of \$6,552,042.05, for the Bayfront Development Plan, Phase 3 Project for the total base bid; and authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute a Construction Materials Testing Agreement with Rock Engineering and Testing Laboratory, Inc. for \$57,960.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The FY 2014 Capital Improvement Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 029916 is amended to add \$156,637.50 in Gas Capital Improvement Program Reserves to the Bayfront Development Plan, Phase 3 project.

SECTION 2. Budgeted funds in the amount of \$218,862.20 are transferred from the Unanticipated Wastewater Capital Requirements Project to the Bayfront Development Plan, Phase 3 project.

SECTION 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a construction contract for the Bayfront Development Plan, Phase 3 construction for the Total Base Bid in the amount of \$6,552,042.05 with Bay, Ltd. of Corpus Christi, Texas

SECTION 4. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a Testing Agreement for the Bayfront Development Plan, Phase 3 in the amount of \$57,960 with Rock Engineering and Testing Laboratory, Inc. of Corpus Christi, Texas
