**Resolution of commitment to the Coastal Bend Water Alliance, declaring unified commitment to the development of regional water supplies**

**CAPTION:**

Resolution of commitment to the Coastal Bend Water Alliance, declaring unified commitment to the development of regional water supplies

**SUMMARY:**

This resolution allows the City of Corpus Christi to formally join the Coastal Bend Water Alliance, an organization initiated by State Senator Adam Hinojosa. The resolution indicates that the city is committed to joining the Alliance, signaling its support for unified water supply solutions and adopting policies that encourage regional cooperation. It also calls upon state and federal entities to provide funding for our regional water supply solutions.

**BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

State Senator Adam Hinojosa initiated a meeting with local governments and water suppliers in Austin during the 89<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislative Session to discuss the development of a Coastal Bend Water Alliance. The proposed organization would facilitate regional discussions amongst suppliers, wholesalers, and customers to spur the development of shared water supply priorities. Each entity desiring to join will pass a resolution formally signaling its support of the Alliance and stating its commitment to participation.

Thus far, San Patricio and Kleberg counties, the San Patricio Municipal Water District, South Texas Water Authority, the Coastal Bend Industry Association, and various municipalities in San Patricio County have passed similar resolutions.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

City Council could choose not to adopt the resolution. Doing so may result in the inability to formally participate in the Coastal Bend Water Alliance meetings and activities.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

None. The resolution is not binding on the city to make any specific financial commitment.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommend the adoption of the resolution to allow the city to fully participate in the Coastal Bend Water Alliance.
