Approval to enter into an interlocal agreement with Nueces County to share the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) and approval to submit a grant application to the U. S. Department of Justice for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY 2013 Local Solicitation

### **CAPTION:**

Resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to submit a grant application in the amount of \$162,583 to the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for funding eligible under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY 2013 Local Solicitation with 50% of the funds to be distributed to Nueces County under the established Interlocal Agreement; and authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute Interlocal Agreement between the City of Corpus Christi and Nueces County to establish terms for the sharing of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Grant (JAG) Program FY 2013 Local Solicitation.

### **PURPOSE:**

The City must apply for these funds each year.

#### **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS**:

Under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) (previously Local Law Enforcement Block Grant LEBG), we have been declared a disparate jurisdiction and have agreed to split the funds 50/50 with Nueces County. A disparate allocation occurs when a constituent unit of local government is scheduled to receive one and one half times more (four times more for multiple units of local government) than another constituent unit(s), while the other unit of local government bears more than 50% of the costs of prosecution or incarceration that arise for Part 1 violent crimes reported by the geographically constituent unit(s).

Jurisdictions certified as disparate must submit a **joint application** for the aggregate of funds allocated to them, specifying the amount of the funds that are to be distributed to each of the units of local government and the purposes for which the funds will be used. When beginning the JAG application process, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) must be completed, signed, and faxed to OJP, indicating who will serve as the applicant/fiscal agent for the joint funds. The City and County have agreed that the City will serve as the lead agency, and the Nueces County Commissioners Court approved the interlocal agreement as well as proposed expenditures on June 19, 2013.

JAG funds can be used for state and local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support, and information systems for criminal justice for any one or more of the following purpose areas:

Law enforcement programs

- Prosecution and court programs
- Prevention and education programs
- Drug treatment and enforcement programs
- Corrections and community corrections programs
- Planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs
