

Ordinance

appropriating \$27,674.58 from the Texas Department of Public Safety, Governor's Division of Emergency Management, in the No. 1062 Fire Grants Fund for FY 2015 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness grant program, phase II & III, to conduct a detailed hazardous materials vulnerability assessment to increase effectiveness in safety and efficiently handling hazardous materials accidents and incidents and to further enhance implementation of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to Know Act of 1986, with a hard match of \$6,918.64;
