Duties

The Landmark Commission promotes the use of historical and cultural landmarks for the culture, prosperity, education, and general welfare of the people of the City and visitors to the City.

Composition

Eleven (11) members are appointed by City Council by majority vote, In so far as possible, the numerical composition shall correspond to the ethnic, gender, and economic distribution of the city according to the last Federal Census report. All members shall have knowledge and experience in either the architectural, archaeological, cultural, social, economic, ethnic or political history of Corpus Christi. No one occupation or professional interest shall constitute a majority membership of the commission. **Membership in one or more of the following categories is preferred but not required: historians, licensed real estate salespersons, architect, structural or civil engineer, title search business, property surveyor and members at-large.** No one profession will constitute a majority of the membership.
