ISSUE:

The Corpus Christi Fire Department (CCFD) seeks to adopt Fire Protection Fees for Fire Department response outside of the Corpus Christi city limits. CCFD seeks a methodology for calculating all-inclusive costs for services rendered to customers when responding outside city limits.

BACKGROUND:

The Corpus Christi Fire Department occasionally responds to emergency calls for service outside the city limits of Corpus Christi. Traditionally, these calls are related to EMS calls for service or single fire unit responses to support a neighboring jurisdiction or in response to a mutual aid request. While calls for fire protection in these areas are infrequent, CCFD does not have an identified methodology for calculating all-inclusive costs for services rendered when responding outside city limits.

Staff will bring this item to City Council for consideration of approval on Tuesday, May 24, 2022.
