Approval to submit a grant application to the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division for funding available under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program

CAPTION:

Resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$35,000 to the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division for funding available under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program to automate Police training records; and authorizing the City Manager or designee to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant.

PURPOSE:

Funding is available from the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division, under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program that provides funds to reduce crime and improve the criminal justice system.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

Currently there is no automation of Police Training records or for the Field Training Officer (FTO) program. Both programs generate over 20,000 documents a year. Automation will provide for easier access, fewer errors, less staff research time, reduced costs for maintaining all documentation, enhanced ability to evaluate a police recruits progress through the FTO program, and numerous other advantages provided through automation.

There is no City match and the grant period will be 10/1/2014 - 9/31/2015.
