Background Information

The Texas Department of Emergency Management, Hazard Mitigation Grant Program – Hurricane Beryl is funded through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency.

The funding is designed to assist the State of Texas in mitigating future disaster damages. These projects may include construction of new facilities, modification of existing, undamaged facilities, relocation of facilities out of floodplains, demolition of structures, or other types of projects to mitigate future disaster damages.

The City of Corpus Christi is requesting \$464,171.00 with a required total cost share of \$116,042.00.
