

Resolution authorizing the purchase of a Prop Series 12 pre-designed and engineered shipping container from Taylor'd Systems, LLC, of Spokane Valley, Washington, for \$76,275.00 to be used for training purposes by the Corpus Christi Fire Department, with FY 2024 funding of \$76,275.00 from the General Fund.

WHEREAS, Taylor'd Systems, LLC, will provide a pre-designed and engineered shipping container, for use by the Corpus Christi Fire Department (CCFD) as a training device, such container being deemed necessary in sustaining the reliability and dependability of services provided by CCFD;

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exception applies;

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a)(2), as this purchase is necessary to preserve and protect the public health or safety of the residents; and

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a)(7)(A), as this purchase is available from only one source due to special processes or patents

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to purchase a container from Taylor'd Systems, LLC, for \$76,275.00 for use by CCFD as a training device, with FY 2024 funding from the General Fund.
