ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO DESIGNATE FROST BANK AS THE DEPOSITORY FOR MUNICIPAL FUNDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 105.016 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A DEPOSITORY SERVICES CONTRACT FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS TO COMMENCE ON JANUARY 1, 2016 AND END ON DECEMBER 31, 2018 WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS

**Whereas**, the City of Corpus Christi through the City Treasurer issued a Request for Applications for depository services;

Whereas, two banks submitted responses which were received and reviewed by City staff;

**Whereas**, the City Council has been presented the specifications of each application in accordance with Section 105.011 of the Texas Local Government Code responses, along with staff recommendation for consideration;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

**Section 1.** That Frost Bank is designated as the municipal depository for municipal funds.

**Section 2**. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a depository services contract with Frost Bank to provide depository banking services, lockbox services and related financial services to the City of Corpus Christi, for a period of 3 years, commencing on January 1, 2016 and ending on December 31, 2018, with an option to renew for two additional one-year periods. A copy of the depository services agreement is attached in substantially final form as Attachment A.
