That \$144,621 is appropriated in the No. 1061 Police Grants Fund from the Officer of the President, Officer of National Drug Control Policy for funding the Police Department's role in the Texas Coastal Corridor Initiative in the FY 2019 HIDTA for the salary and benefits of one civilian employee and overtime for four Corpus Christi Police Officers.
