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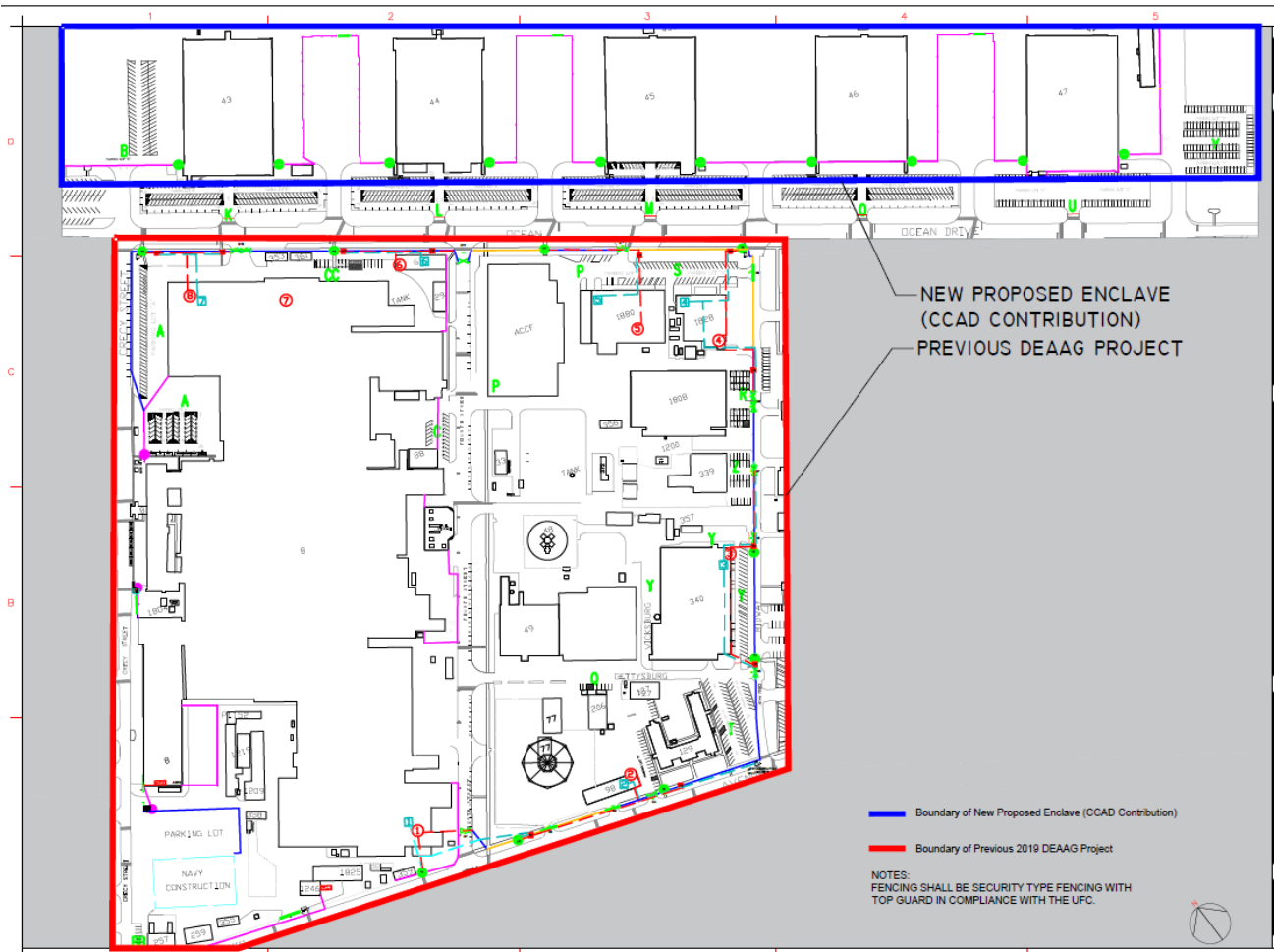


DEAAG Project

The existing paved roadway on the CCAD Flight Line follows a winding path that causes safety concerns for transport of aircraft, vehicular traffic and airfield operations.

Project will:

- Construct a new 30 foot wide concrete roadway with 2 twelve foot travel lanes
 - Remove faded and non-compliant aircraft parking stalls and helipads
 - Remove and relocate infrastructure in the path of the new roadway
 - Construct and stripe new aircraft parking, helipads, and other safety measures
 - CCAD will contribute \$1.95 million in security improvements surrounding the hangars and flight line to secure the facility to standards
 - Address security and safety concerns for the Army to help attract future aircraft platform missions to CCAD
