

Ordinance authorizing acceptance of a grant from the Executive Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy, in an amount of \$89,480.00 for the FY2020 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Initiative; and appropriating \$89,480.00 in the Police Grants Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept a grant in the amount of \$89,480 from the Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy to support the Police Department's role in the Texas Coastal Corridor Initiative in the FY 2020 Houston High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) for overtime for four Corpus Christi Police Officers and four lease vehicles.

SECTION 2. That \$89,480 is appropriated in the No. 1061 Police Grants Fund from the Office of the President, Office of National Drug Control Policy for funding the Police Department's role in the Texas Coastal Corridor Initiative in the FY 2020 HIDTA for overtime for four Corpus Christi Police Officers and four lease vehicles.
