

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$189,229.31 OF ANTICIPATED REVENUES FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE NO. 1041, STREET FUND; AMENDING FY 2014-2015 OPERATIONAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 030294 TO INCREASE REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES BY \$189,229.31 EACH; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH ACM HUB, LLC OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$236,536.64 FOR THE CITYWIDE SIGNAGE UPGRADE (STREET PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM PROJECT) FOR THE TOTAL BASE BID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. An amount of \$189,229.31 in anticipated revenues from the Texas Department of Transportation is appropriated in No. 1041 Street Fund.

SECTION 2. The FY 2015 Operating Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 030290 is changed to increase revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$189,229.31 each.

SECTION 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a construction contract for the Citywide Signage Upgrade project in the amount of \$236,536.64 with ACM HUB, LLC of San Antonio, Texas as part of the Street Preventative Maintenance program for the total base bid.
