Ordinance authorizing Amendment No. 5 to the service agreement with Sec-Ops, Inc., for citywide security guard services for an amount not to exceed \$410,904.13, with FY 2023 funding from various funds.

WHEREAS, the City entered into Service Agreement No. 2436, which was effective on November 1, 2019, with a three-year term, for citywide security guard services;

WHEREAS, the continuation of services is needed through January 31, 2024, with funding provided from accounts previously authorized by the City Council in accordance with the parties' executed service agreement.
