

Future Challenges

- Orderly Growth
 - Residential, commercial, retail, industrial
 - Balancing economic vs societal site selection
- Maintaining Clean Air and Water
 - Incremental degradation
 - Reduce future environmental opposition
- Traffic/Rail Safety and System Efficiency
- Infrastructure Costs
 - City, County, School Districts, Special Districts, TxDOT, AEP, etc.
- Additional Industrial Growth is Probable



Scope of the Plan

- Identify tracts most suitable for industrial purposes.
- Identify tracts most suitable for residential, commercial, and retail development.
- Identify infrastructure needs.
- Identify traffic/rail patterns; establish thoroughfare plans.
- Create incentives for developing in industrial zones.
- Create disincentives for misplaced development.

Project Execution

- Identify neutral body to oversee a consultant who will develop the master plan.

- Implement plan elements including incentive mechanisms.
- Ongoing enforcement.
