Proposed Operating Agreement





- Turo is a peer-to-peer carsharing company based in San Francisco, California.
- The company launched in 2012. Usage skyrocketed during COVID and it has grown since.
- Turo operates in the Corpus Christi community today, and many vehicle owners offer the ability to pick up their vehicle at Corpus Christi International Airport.
- Today, these vehicles are parked in Short Term and exchanged with renters without any revenue of this transaction being captured by the City.







Proposed Operating Agreement



- The operating agreement gives Turo the ability to operate in the paid parking lots of CCIA for a percentage of gross revenue.
- The term of the operating agreement is for one year, with two one-year options for renewal.
- City Staff recommends approval of the five-year lease agreement.
- The Airport Board recommended approval of the lease agreement at their special called meeting on January 29, 2024.
