

Ordinance accepting \$1,611,159.39 grant from the Office of the Governor from the Texas Military Preparedness Commission for the Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant (DEAAG) with a cash match of \$387,000.00; appropriating \$1,611,159.39 from the Community Development Grant Fund to provide funding for wastewater collection system line & manhole replacement in support of Naval Air Station Corpus Christi; and amending the FY2023 Capital Budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept a grant totaling \$1,611,159.39 from the State of Texas Office of the Governor from the Defense Economic Adjustment Assistance Grant (DEAAG) with a cash match of \$387,000, to provide funding for wastewater collection system line & manhole replacement in support of Naval Air Station Corpus Christi.

SECTION 2. Funds in the amount of \$1,611,159.39 from the Community Development Grant Fund No. 1072 are appropriated for wastewater collection system line & manhole replacement in support of Naval Air Station Corpus Christi.

SECTION 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any future amendments to the Contract which extend the contract period or increase or decrease the amount of the grant.

SECTION 4. The Corpus Christi FY2022-2023 Capital Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 032856 is amended to add the Naval Air Station Corpus Christi wastewater collection system line & manhole replacement project and to increase expenditures by \$1,998,159.00.

SECTION 5. A copy of the executed grant shall be filed in the office of the City Secretary.
