

Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)



Council Presentation November 28, 2023





The TxDOT HSIP provides grant funding for 90% of the construction costs of highway safety projects aimed to eliminate or reduce the number of severe traffic collisions. Under this program, the local government entity is responsible for all other costs such as design, right of way, permitting, TxDOT administrative fees, and construction change orders. HSIP funding provides for construction costs with a 90/10 funding participation by State (TxDOT)/Local Governments (City of Corpus Christi), respectively. The HSIP grant requires that the construction project be advertised and awarded by TxDOT.

This AFA is for the Group III projects which will enhance traffic signals, interconnect signals, and flashing beacons. Listed below is the project location:

Airline at McArdle

The total estimated cost for the projects is \$416,904.79, of which TxDOT is responsible up to a maximum cost of \$329,540.19 and city is responsible for the remaining amount of \$87,364.60. Upon approval of the AFA, the project will be advertised for bidding by TxDOT in November 2023.
