Litter Ordinance Campaign Research



- •Individuals under 30 are more likely to litter than those who are older
- •Individuals are more likely to litter into a littered environment (Source: Keep America Beautiful Inc. website www.kab.org)

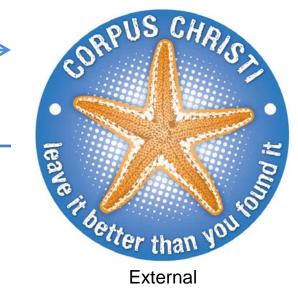
Litter Ordinance Awareness Benchmark Survey

Conducted April 8-10, 2014 with 302 adults surveyed and a MoE of 5.7%

- •77% supported the ordinance & 11% opposed the ordinance
- •20% had heard something regarding the ordinance & 77% had heard nothing
- •Most perceived litter items:
 - Plastic bags 50%
 - •Paper 29%
 - •Plastic Bottle 24%
 - Styrofoam cups 23%
 - •Aluminum cans 18%
 - Food & restaurant waste 15%
 - •Rubber/car tires 14%
 - Discarded furniture 13%
 - •Cardboard boxes 4%
 - •Wooden products 2%
 - •Discarded car parts 1%
 - •Other 21%
 - Didn't know or refused to answer 6%

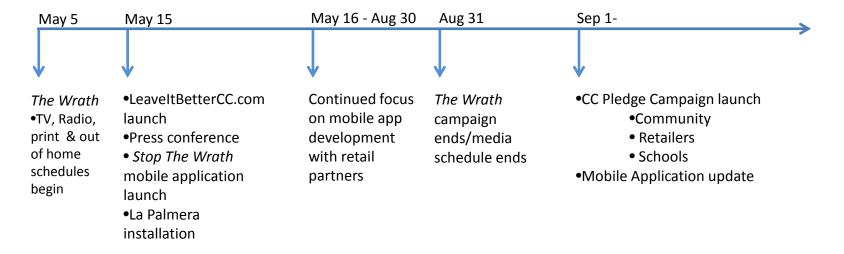
