The FAA Airports District Office has reviewed the aviation forecast for the Corpus Christi International Airport (CRP) Domestic Redevelopment Program dated July 2, 2024. The FAA approves these forecasts for airport planning purposes, including Airport Layout Plan (ALP) development, in addition to the existing and future critical aircraft.

Our approval is based on the following:

- The forecast is supported by reasonable planning assumptions and current data
- The forecast appears to be developed using acceptable forecasting methodologies
- The difference between the FAA Terminal Area Forecast (TAF) and the Airport's forecast for total operations is within the 10 percent and 15 percent allowance for the 5- and 10-year planning horizons.

- Approval Based on the Following
  - Reasonable Planning Assumptions
  - Current Data
  - Acceptable Forecasting Methods
  - The Difference Between FAA's Forecast and CClA's Within 10% for a 10-year Planning Period
- Huge Milestone for the Master Planning Process
