

Park & Recreation Department: Maximo Implementation Project

Project Status Report

Project Summary:

This project was to incorporate the Parks and Recreation Departments assets for the Parks Operations Division, Beach Operations Division, Recreation Division, Public Art Collection, Nutritional Education Service Center, and Marina into Maximo. This will include the cost and life span of the assets and capture preventative maintenance data.

Preventive Maintenance and Job Plans

IT Department in collaboration with Parks & Recreation Department, developed and implemented 45 Preventative Maintenance schedules with 56 Job Plans with tasks within them. 20 Routes identified and added to the Preventative Maintenance schedule for Work Order generation for each asset.
