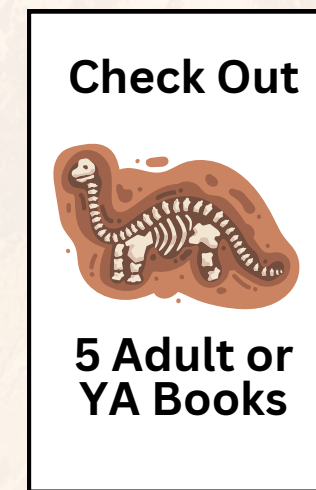

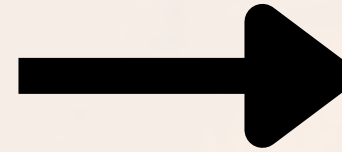
- **Attend an 18+ Program at any Library.**

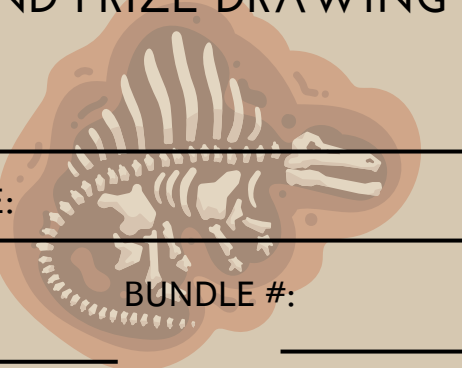
