## **Background Information**

Federal funds are available under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG) for projects that promote public safety, reduce crime, and improve the criminal justice system.

In-car camera systems have proven to be effective in capturing video that is relevant to successful prosecutions, clearing or substantiating complaints, and documenting events that could create a liable action for or against a municipality or county agency.

The City of Corpus Christi has received an award of \$39,993.25.



## **This grant will provide funding for:** The purchase of 10 additional in-car camera systems.

The 10 additional in-car camera systems will expand CCPD's inventory of in-car camera systems needed for marked patrol vehicles. The 10 additional in-car camera systems will eventually be installed by a licensed Panasonic installer as part of the vehicle upfitting process for 10 patrol police vehicles.

The 10 patrol police vehicles are expected to be received by CCPD in Spring 2025.
