One-reading ordinance authorizing a construction contract with Fulton Coastcon General Contractors of Corpus Christi, Texas for the construction of the City of Corpus Christi's new Police Training Academy in the amount of \$21,154,706 and authorizing a professional services contract amendment No. 3 with Turner Ramirez & Associates, Inc, Corpus Christi, Texas, for construction phase services in the amount of \$93,953 for a total restated fee not to exceed \$1,199,553, located in Council District 5; amending the FY 2023 Capital Budget; with funding available from Certificates of Obligation and General Fund.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

- **SECTION 1.** The FY 2022-2023 Capital Budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 032856, is amended to increase expenditures by \$3,763,536.
- **SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a construction contract with Fulton Coastcon General Contractors in an amount not to exceed \$21,154,706 for the Police Training Academy project.
- **SECTION 3.** The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a Amendment No. 3 to the professional services agreement with Turner Ramirez & Associates, Inc, Corpus Christi, Texas, for construction phase services in the amount of \$93,953 for a total restated fee not to exceed \$1,199,553 for the Police Training Academy project.
- **SECTION 4.** That upon written request of the Mayor of five Council members, copy attached, the City Council (1) finds and declares an emergency due to the need for immediate action necessary for the efficient and effective administration of City affairs and (2) suspends the Charter rule that requires consideration of and voting upon ordinances at two regular meetings so that this ordinance is passed and takes effect upon first reading as an emergency measure on this the \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of December, 2022.
