Background

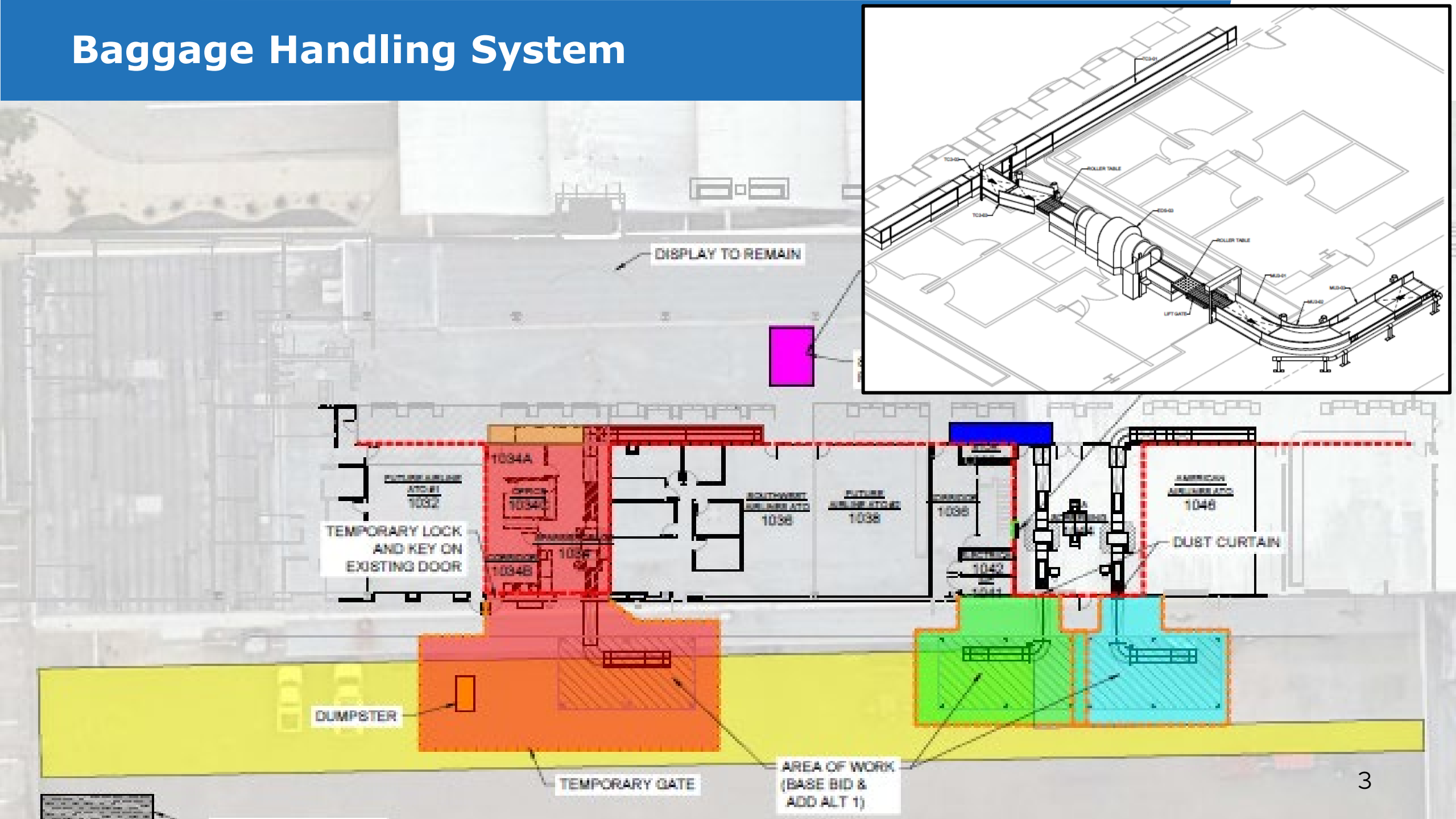
The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) provides entitlement grants to airports under the Airport Improvement Program. Entitlement funding is based on the amount of commercial enplanements in a given year. CCIA is typically eligible to receive ~\$2.7M a year for airport improvement projects. Grant 73 is a combination of FY 26, 25, and partial FY 24 for a total amount of \$7,711,443. The Airport is required to provide 5% matching funds.

This funding will be used for the following three projects:

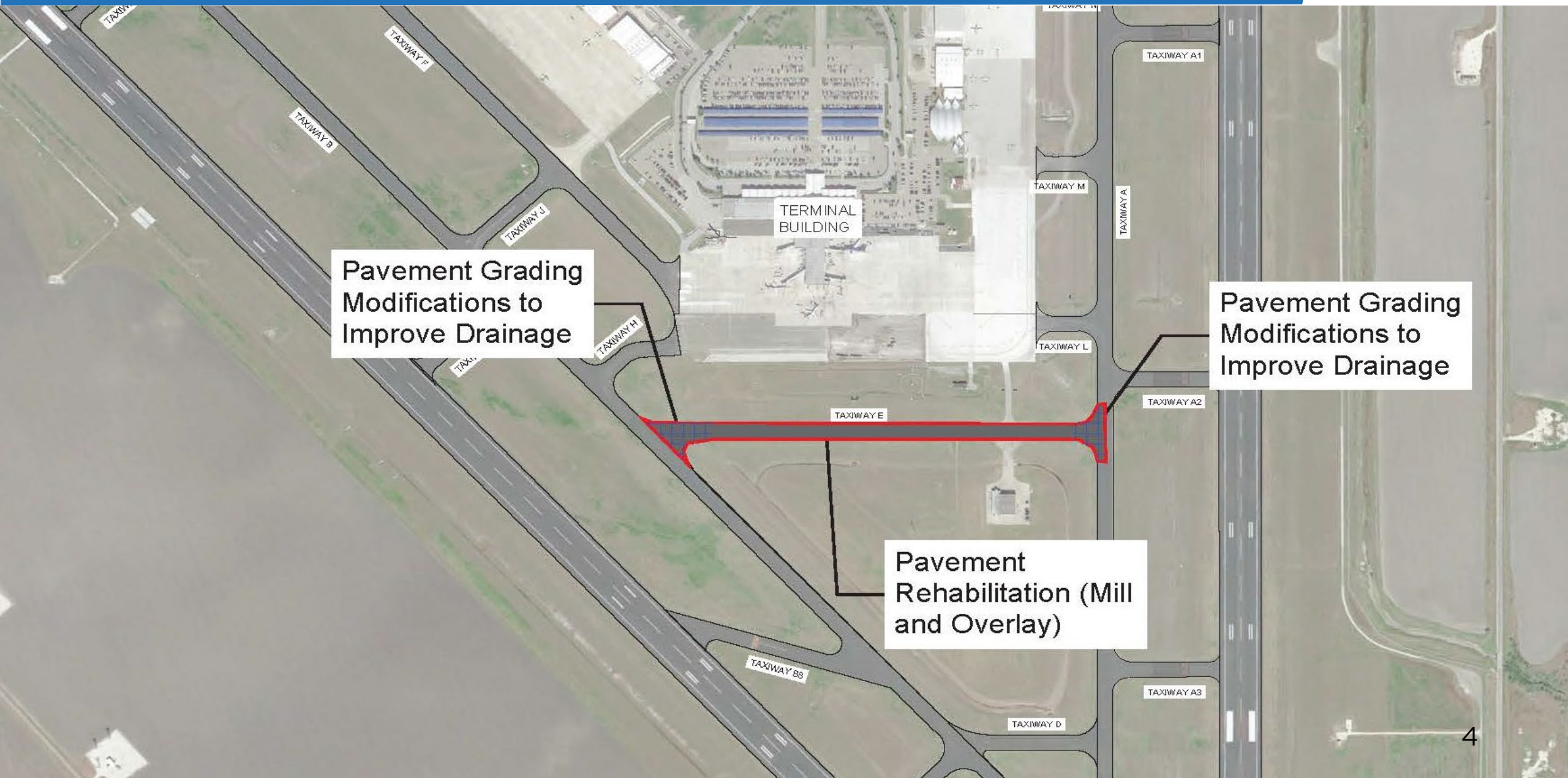
1. Terminal Rehabilitation Phase III, Baggage Handling System Upgrade
2. Taxiway E Rehabilitation
3. Taxiway K West Apron (Design)

Each construction project will be bid out and presented to City Council individually through the Engineering Department

Baggage Handling System



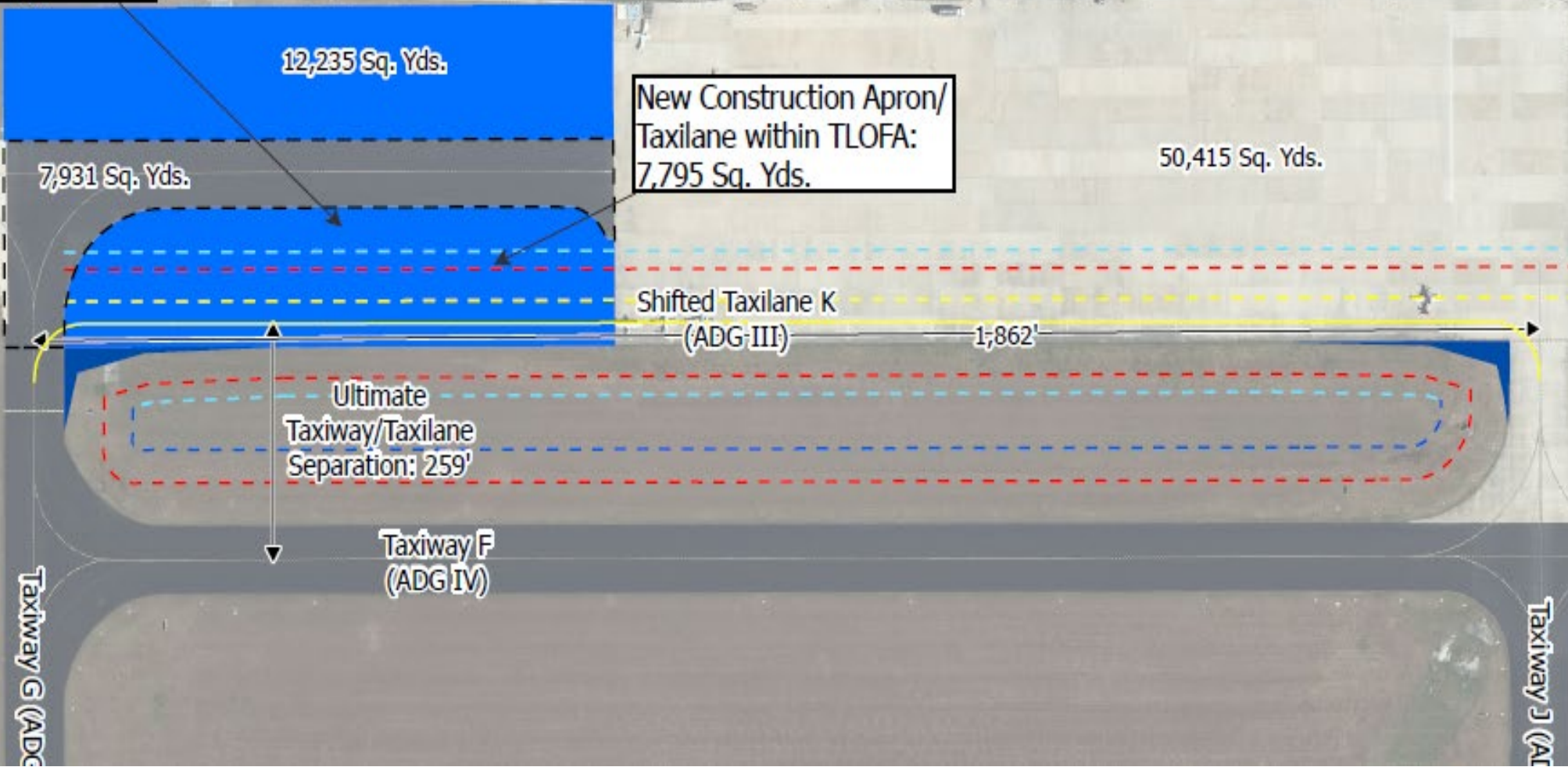
Taxiway E Rehabilitation

Summary

Airport staff recommends accepting and appropriating funding through FAA AIP Grant 73 to use all available FY 24 – 26 entitlement funds (\$7,711,443) for the following three project:

1. Terminal Rehabilitation Phase III, Baggage Handling System Upgrade
2. Taxiway E Rehabilitation
3. Taxiway K West Apron (Design)

The airport has budgeted the 5% local match in the FY-26 budget (\$384,044.40)
