Senate Bill 22

- Authored by Senator Joan Huffman and Representative Todd Hunter
- Creates the Texas Moving Image Industry Incentive Fund and provides \$500 million in funding
- Creates an incentive to increase the number of Texans employed in the film/television industry and the number of productions made in Texas.



Incentives

- Incentives are provided from the state to the individual production companies
- Establishes a graduated increase in incentives based on the value of expenditures made in Texas, requiring the production to spend a minimum of \$500,000 in-state.
- Creates bonus incentives for productions that employ veterans, faith-based productions, rural production locations, or portray Texas culture in a positive light.
